What we did.

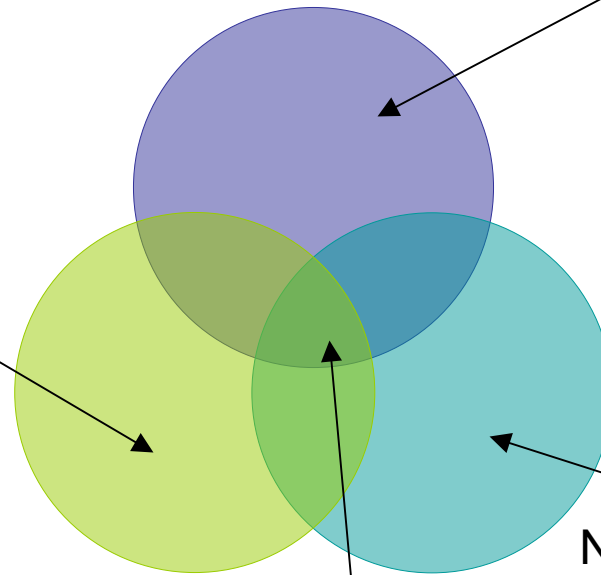
- We observed our squares, by laying four yard sticks in a square shape.
