



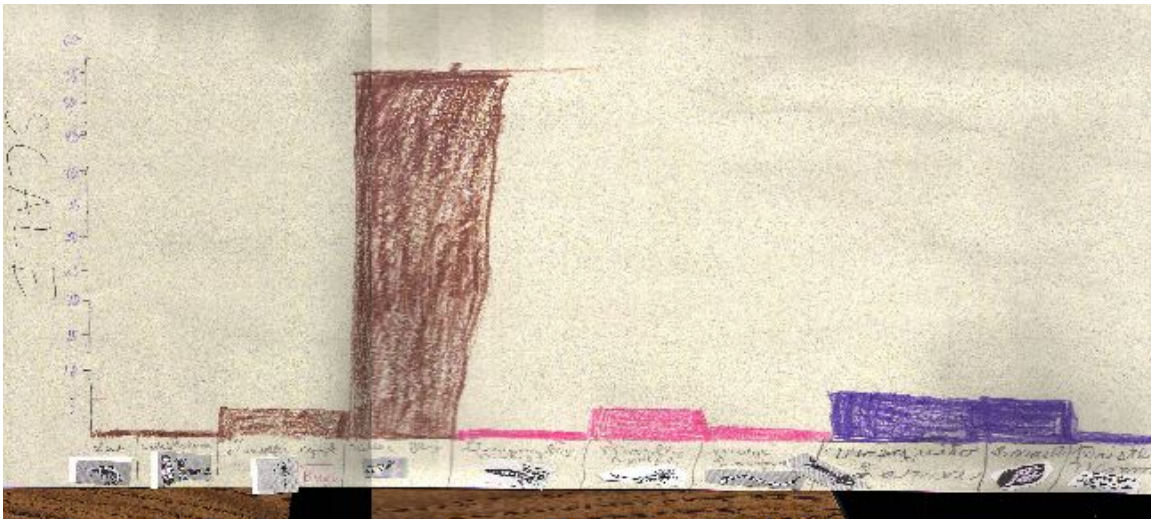
**Emanuel Lutheran School
